## Facts about trail funding

## Do trails just appear?

Many of our members understand that there are many things that go into putting snowmobile trails in place. But do you realize how snowmobile trail funding comes from all of us working together? It begins with the landowners, clubs, county associations to the DNR. All of us working together leads to trail funding which means we can hopefully make trails better in the future.

## **Assembly Bill 180**

If you are receive emails from the club an email was sent out earlier this week requesting you to support Assembly Bill 180 also known as AB180 to increase the \$250 per mile for trail maintenance to \$300 per mile and the supplemental from

\$150 to \$200 per mile. The current rates have not changed in almost 20 years. Also included in this bill is to eliminate the sunset clause of the trail pass. The trail pass was originally set for 4 years. The trail pass fees would become a permanent funding source. If you get a chance where you can contact your legislator or send a letter asking them to support this bill would be helpful. I have included an example of a letter you could use as a guide. ### **April Meeting**

Our last meeting of the season is Friday, April 7th at Fireside. The meeting will take place in the garage meeting room

across from the bar. The election of President and Secretary/Treasurer will be at this meeting. Some of the members stay after the meeting for dinner and visiting. We usually have some good conversation and laughs! Hope you can make the last meeting.

#### **AWSC** numbers

Some interesting numbers regarding membership. Total membership of the AWSC thru the end of February - there are 615 clubs for a total of 41,595 memberships. Keep in mind each membership be it family or single only counts as one. I found this interesting that the Back 40 is in the top 36% of membership. There are 392 clubs smaller! As clubs, we

still have our work cut out for us. End of 2016 there were 196,000 registered sleds and only 128,254 trail passes sold and only 65.590 sold by the AWSC. Remember each pass sold by the DNR cost \$30 each. With membership to the AWSC the cost is \$10 per sled. Example you have a family of 4 buying passes from the DNR for \$120. If a member of the Back 40 it would be \$25 membership and \$40 for the passes if you have 4 sleds for a total of \$65. So, it is costing you almost 50% less and you receive the benefits of the AWSC, WSN magazine and information from the club.
